


PARTS OF A TOMATO


Color each part of the tomato below. Then, cut open a tomato and compare what you see with the pictures below!



The stem attaches the fruit to the plant and helps the fruit get water and nutrients.



The mesocarp is the "meaty" part of a tomato. It is sometimes called the flesh.



The funiculus protects and holds the seeds in place.



Seeds help the plant reproduce.
